

ORDINANCE NO. 2516

An Ordinance amending Sections 23, 5, 7, 27, 9, 17, 33, 14, and 29 of Ordinance No. 2483 of the City of Everett, providing for the fixing and determining of the number and designation of the various officers, assistants, deputys and employees of the City of Everett and the various departments thereof, prescribing the duties of such officers, assistants, deputys and employees, fixing their salaries and repealing Ordinance No. 2493 and all other ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE CITY OF EVERETT DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 5: There shall be the following named officers and assistants in the Police Department, to-wit: One Chief of Police, One Captain, who shall also be Chief of Detectives, One Chief of Bureau of Identifications, Three Desk Sergeants, three Plain-clothes Men, sixteen First-Class Patrolmen, two Second-class patrolmen, one Third-Class patrolman, one policewoman, one Jailor-Cook, one Stenographer (half time), one Traveler's Aid, Patrolmen for the first year of service shall be classed as third class patrolmen; patrolmen for the second year of service shall be classed at second-class patrolmen; and patrolmen for the third year of service and thereafter shall be classed as first class patrolmen. The Chief of Police shall be the administrative head of the Police Department. It shall be the duty of the officers and assistants in said department to perform the duties indicated by the name of their employment and such other duties as the Chief of Police and Commissioner of Safety authorizes and directs.

Section 2: That Section 23⁵ of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 23⁶: POLICE DEPARTMENT Chief of Police, Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars per month. Captain and Chief of Detectives, One Hundred eighty-five (\$185.00) Dollars per month.

Chief of Identification Bureau, One Hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) Dollars per month.

Desk Sergeants, One Hundred sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

Plain Clothes Men, One Hundred sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

First-Class Patrolmen, One Hundred fifty-five (\$155.00) Dollars per month.

Second-Class Patrolmen, One Hundred forty-five (\$145.00) Dollars per month.

Third-Class Patrolmen, One Hundred forty (\$140.00) Dollars per month.

Police Woman, One Hundred twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars per month.

Jailor-Cook, One Hundred forty (\$140.00) Dollars per month.

Stenographer (one-half time) Fifty-five (\$55.00) Dollars per month.

Traveler's Aid, twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per month.

Section 3: That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 7: There shall be the following names officers and assistants in the Fire Department, to-wit: Chief of Fire Department, Assistant Chief of Fire Department, Second Assistant Chief of Fire Department, Secretary, Superintendent of Fire and Police Signal System, Assistant Superintendent of Fire and Police Signal System, Master Mechanic, Assistant Master Mechanic, six Captains, twelve Auto Drivers, three Fire Alarm Operators, thirteen ~~Chief~~ First Grade Pipemen and one second grade pipeman. The Chief of the Fire Department shall be the administrative head of the Department. It shall be the duty of the assistants in said Department to perform the duties indicated by the name of their employment, and such other duties as the Chief of the Fire Department or the Commissioner of Public Safety may authorize and direct.

Section 4: That Section 27 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 27: FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Chief of Fire Department, Two Hundred and twenty-five (\$225.00) per month.

Assistant Chief, One Hundred and Ninety (\$190.00) Dollars per month.

Second Assistant Chief, One Hundred and seventy-five (\$175.00) Dollars per month.

Secretary, One Hundred and sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

Superintendent Fire and Police Signal, One Hundred and seventy (\$170.00) Dollars per month.

Assistant Superintendent Fire and Police Signal, One Hundred and sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

Master Mechanic, One Hundred and Seventy (\$170.00) Dollars per month.

Assistant Master Mechanic, One Hundred and sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

Captains, One Hundred and Seventy (\$170.00) Dollars per month.

Auto Drivers, One Hundred and fifty-five (\$155.00) Dollars per month.

Fire Alarm Operators, One Hundred and fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per month.

First Grade Pipemen, One Hundred and Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per month.

Second Grade Pipemen, One Hundred and thirty-five (\$135.00) Dollars per month.

Section 5: That Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 9: There shall be the following named officers and assistants in the street and sewer Department, to-wit: Street Superintendent, Barn Man, Tractor Man, Five Truck Drivers, five Repair Men, Two Laborers, One Push Up Man, Two Sewer Inspectors, One Street Marker. The Superintendent of Streets shall be the administrative head of this Department. All of the above named assistants shall perform the duties indicated by the name of their respective employment and such other duties as the Superintendent of Streets or the Commissioner of Public Works shall from time to time authorize and determine.

Section 6: That Section 17 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 17: There shall be in the office of the Library Department, the following named officers, to-wit: One librarian, One Children's Librarian, One Order and School Reference

One Cataloger, One Circulation Librarian, One Typist, and Office Assistant, One First Clerical Librarian, One Janitor, also part time Assistants, Pages, Menders and Substitutes. The Librarian shall be in general charge and supervision of the Library Department. The other officers and assistants shall perform such duties as pertain to the nature of their office and as authorized and directed by the Librarian.

Section 7: That Section 23 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 23: City Clerk, Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars per month.

Deputy City Clerk, One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

Office Clerk and License Inspector, One Hundred Forty (\$140.00) Dollars per month.

Stenographer and Clerk (Part Time) Ninety (\$90.00) Dollars per month.

Section 8: That Section 33 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 33: LIBRARY DEPARTMENT.

Librarian, One Hundred Ninety-Five (\$195.00) Dollars per month.

Children's Librarian, One Hundred Forty-Five (\$145.00) Dollars per month.

Order and School Reference Librarian, One Hundred Thirty (\$130.00) Dollars per month.

Cataloger, One Hundred Eighteen and 33/100 (\$118.33) Dollars per month.

Circulation Librarian, One Hundred Twelve and 50/100 (\$112.50) Dollars per month.

First Circulation Librarian (Desk, Clerical and Bookwagon, Part Time) Sixty-Two and 50/100 (\$62.50) Dollars per month.

Janitor, Sixty-Two and 50/100 (\$62.50) per month.

Section 9: That Section 14 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 14: There shall be in the office of the Water Department, the following named officers, assistants and employes, to-wit: Superintendent, General Foreman, Headworks Operator, Operator Three Lakes Station, Operator Panther Creek Station, Draughtsman, Engineer, Inspector, Stenographer, Clerk, Sultan Line Foreman, Hydrant Flusher, Yard Foreman, Blacksmith, Blacksmith's Helper, Auto Repairman, Meter Repairman, Serviceman, Foreman, Pipefitter, Pipefitter's Helper, Truck Driver,

Pickup Driver, Caretaker, Janitor, Carpenter, Welder Foreman, Welder, Air Compressor Operator, Tractor Operator, Laborers. The Superintendent shall be in general charge and supervision of the Water Department; the other employes and assistants shall perform such duties as pertain to the nature of their office and as authorized and directed by the Superintendent.

Section 10: That Section 29 of Ordinance No. 2483 be amended so as to read as follows, to-wit: "Section 29: WATER DEPARTMENT.

Superintendent, Two Hundred Twenty-Five (\$225.00) Dollars per month.

General Foreman, One Hundred Seventy-Five (\$175.00) Dollars per month.

Headworks Operator, One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

Operator Three Lakes Station, One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per month.

Operator Panther Creek Station, One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per month.

Draughtsman, One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars per month.

Engineer, One Hundred Ninety (\$190.00) Dollars per month.

Inspector, One Hundred Forty (\$140.00) Dollars per month.

Stenographer, One Hundred Ten (\$110.00) Dollars per month.

Clerk, One Hundred Ten (\$110.00) Dollars Per month.

Sultan Line Foreman, One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars per month.

Hydrant Flusher, Four and 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars per day.

Yard Foreman, Six and no/100 (\$6.00) Dollars per day.

Blacksmith, Six and no/100 (\$6.00) Dollars per day.

Blacksmith's Helper, Four and 75/100 (\$4.75) Dollars per day.

Auto Repairman, Six and no/100 (\$6.00) Dollars per day.

Meter Repairman, Six and no/100 (\$6.00) Dollars per day.

Serviceman, Six and no/100 (\$6.00) Dollars per day.

Foreman, Six and no/100 (\$6.00) Dollars per day.

Pipefitter, Five and 50/100 (\$5.50) Dollars per day.

Pipefitter's Helper, Four and 50/100 (\$4.50) Dollars per day.

Truck Driver, Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars per day.

Pickup Driver, Four and 50/100 (\$4.50) Dollars per day.

Caretaker, Four and 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars per day.

Janitor, Four and 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars per day.

Carpenter, Five and 50/100 (\$5.50) Dollars per day.

Welder Foreman, Seven and no/100 Dollars (\$7.00) per day.

Welder, Six and no/100 (\$6.00) Dollars per day.

Air Compressor Operator, Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars per day.

Tractor Operator, Five and no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars per day.

Laborers, Four and 25/100 (\$4.25) Dollars per day.

It is further provided that whenever an emergency shall arise in the Water Department which shall require the immediate use of additional employees in said department, the Council may by resolution provide for the employment and salaries or wages of said additional employees for the period of said emergency.

Section 11: This Ordinance shall take effect and be of full force and effect as of February 1st, 1931.

Section 23, Ordinance No. 2483: City Clerk, \$200.00 per month. Deputy City Clerk, \$160.00 per month. Office Clerk and License Inspector, \$140.00 per month. Stenographer and Clerk, \$90.00 per month (part time).

Section 5, Ordinance No. 2483: Chief of Police, \$200.00 per month. Chief of Detectives (Captain), \$175.00 per month. Chief of Bureau of Identification, \$175.00 per month. Three desk sergeants, \$160.00 per month. Three plain clothes men, \$160.00 per month. Patrolmen (16) 1st Class, \$155.00 per month. Patrolmen (2) 2nd Class, \$145.00 per month. Patrolman (1) 3rd Class, \$140.00 per month. Police Woman, \$125.00 per month. Jailor-Cook, \$140.00 per month. Stenographer ($\frac{1}{2}$ salary) per month, \$55.00. Traveler's Aid, \$25.00 per month.

Section 7, Ordinance No. 2483: Chief of Fire Department, Assistant Chief of Fire Department, 2nd Assistant Chief of Fire Department, Secretary, Superintendent of Fire and Police Signal System, Assistant Superintendent of Fire and Police Signal System, Master Mechanic, Assistant Master Mechanic, Six Captains, Twelve Auto Drivers, Three Fire Alarm Operators, Thirteen 1st Grade Pipemen, One 2nd Grade Pipeman.

Section 27, Ordinance No. 2483: Amend so as to leave out "Lieutenant", which is not provided for in this years budget.

Section 9, Ordinance No. 2483: Street Superintendent, Barn Man, Tractor Man, Five Truck Drivers, Five Repair Men, Two Laborers, One Push Up Man, Two Sewer Inspectors, One Street Marker.


