ORDINANCE NO. 1765

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting the sale of cigars, cigarettes, cigarette paper, or tobacco in any form, to minors.

THE CITY OF EVERETT DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: No person shall, within the city of Everett, sell, or give, or permit to be sold or given to any person under the age of twenty-one years, any cigar, cigarette, cigarette paper or wrapper, or tobacco, in any form. It shall be no defense to a prosecution for a violation of this section that a minor acted or was believed by the defendant to have acted as agent or representative of another.

Section 2: No person under the age of twenty-one years shall purchase, or have in his or her possession any cigar, cigarette, cigarette paper, or tobacco in any form.

. Section 3: Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred (\$100) dollars, or by imprisonment for a period of not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4: An emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
