

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ("BACK ON TRACK" AMENDMENT)

This Amendment to Contract ("Amendment") is effective as of the date of the last signature below, and is between the City of Everett, a Washington municipal corporation (the "City"), and the Contractor identified below ("Contractor" or "Boadus"). The City and Contractor are parties to the Contract described below, as may have been previously amended ("Contract"), which concerns the project identified below ("Project").

In consideration of the terms and conditions set forth below, and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Contractor agree as set forth below:

1. Background Information

Circumstances of Amendment	This Project has been repeatedly delayed. Contractor has not provided schedules or submittals as required. The City has provided Contractor warning letters. The City has provided notice that it intends to terminate the Contract and transfer Contract performance to the Contractor's surety. The purpose of this Amendment is to (1) avoid Contract termination, (2) document comprehensively the current status of the Project, and (3) establish the Contractor's commitments for schedule and Project completion. Contractor understands this amendment is a last chance. Failure to meet the requirements of this Amendment will result immediate Contract termination with no opportunities to cure.

7. Project Going Forward

- **A.** <u>Contract Time</u>. Contract Time is extended so that Project completion is required in accordance with the schedule in Section 6 above.
- **B.** <u>Project Materials</u>. Contractor will provide the City Project Team, which consists of Lisa Page, Lolly Huggins, Jenny Chang, and Theresa Bauccio-Teschlog, with weekly updates to the materials table in Section 3 above. **Updates are due each Monday at 8 A.M. starting October 20, 2025**. The City may issue joint checks to Contractor and suppliers.
- C. <u>Project Subcontractors</u>. Contractor will provide the City Project Team with weekly updates to the subcontractors' table in Section 4 above. **Updates are due each Monday at 8 A.M. starting October 20, 2025.** No Project subcontractor may be added without written approval of the City Project Manager. No Project subcontractor may be terminated without written approval of the City Project Manager. The City may issue joint checks to Contractor and subcontractors.
- **D.** <u>Project Submittals.</u> Contractor will provide complete submittals by the deadline as set forth above in the table in Section 5 above. If requested by the Contractor in writing, the City Project Manager may extend the deadlines in the table, but such extension is at the City Project Manager's sole discretion. Any extension is only effective if given in writing.
- E. <u>Project Schedule</u>. No onsite work is allowed until the Work Restart Date. Contractor will achieve the milestones by the deadlines as set forth above in the table in Section 6 above. If requested by the Contractor in writing, the City Project Manager may extend the deadlines in the table, but such extension is at the City Project Manager's sole discretion. Any extension is only effective if given in writing.
- **F**. <u>Contract Termination</u>. In addition to other items constituting Contractor default set forth in the Contract, the following are additional items constituting Contractor default, each of which is a Contract default entitling the City to terminate the Contract under Contract Section 1.28.A:
 - (1) Any untrue certification in the tables in Sections 2-4 above.
 - (2) Any failure to update the tables in Section 3 and 4 above.

- (3) Any failure to meet any submittal deadline in Section 5 above.
- (4) Any failure to meet a schedule milestone in Section 6 above.

TIME IS OF THE ESSENSE FOR ALL MATTERS IN THIS AMENDMENT.

8. Other Provisions

- **A.** This Amendment may be signed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which, taken together, shall be deemed one and the same document. AdobeSign signatures are fully binding. Any ink, electronic, faxed, scanned, photocopied, or similarly reproduced signature on this Amendment will be deemed an original signature and will be fully enforceable as an original signature.
- **B**. All provisions in the Contract shall remain in effect except as expressly modified by this Amendment. From and after the effective date of this Contract, all references to the Contract in the Contract are deemed references to the Contract as modified by this Amendment.
- **C**. Contractor will not refer in any way to the City of Everett in Contractor's websites, advertisements, or any other public facing media. Contractor will remove all references to the City of Everett from Contractor's websites, advertisements, and any other public facing media.
